- 1. Would The District consider allowing bidders to provide multiple options for device categories? No. Send the best cost for the device that you are offering that will meet or exceed specifications.
- 2. Will The District consider AMD equivalent processors?
- 3. Processor specs say Pentium and also say i5. Is Pentium/N200 processor what is required for the student device?

I5 performance or equivalent. Please see Addendum 1

4. If 14" devices will give more cost-effective laptop options, would this screen size be acceptable for the student laptop?

- 15. If a demo is requested, how quickly would you expect to receive the demo unit? We would expect the demo unit by 9/13/24
- 16. What is the expected delivery time on these orders after a purchase order has been issued? Hardware delivery is expected ten (10) days after PO is received. Any delays should be communicated.
- 17. Can you provide a Microsoft Shape the Future letter?

- 18. Is Intel 12th Generation acceptable or do you require 13th Generation? The latest generation is expected
- 19. Is additional drop testing required on the laptops?

 For the Tablets, Advanced Exchange is acceptable but the bidder can only submit 1 (one) warranty type per device with the exception of the 2 warranty types required for Student device (1). See Addendum 1.

- 22. Is the 5MP camera required? That is high quality for the level of computer you are requesting. 5MP wasn't requested
- 23. Our understanding is that a bond is not required for this opportunity. Can you please confirm if this is correct?

That is correct, it is not required.

- 24. Do you know the size of the devices that will need to be in the charging carts? Cart needs to fit 15inch laptop
- 25. We would need to confirm the device models they will be using or the size to make sure they will fit inside the cart shelves.
 - a. What is the power plug?
 More clarity is required to provide a response.
 - b. Do they request power connectors be included or are they going to use their own connectors? (prewiring?)

- d. Will all carts be delivered at the same time to one location? Does the location have a loading dock? All carts will be delivered to the deployment vendor.
